

- *The story teaches obedience to Allah SWT, seeking forgiveness, and being good representatives without arrogance.*



# LESSON 2

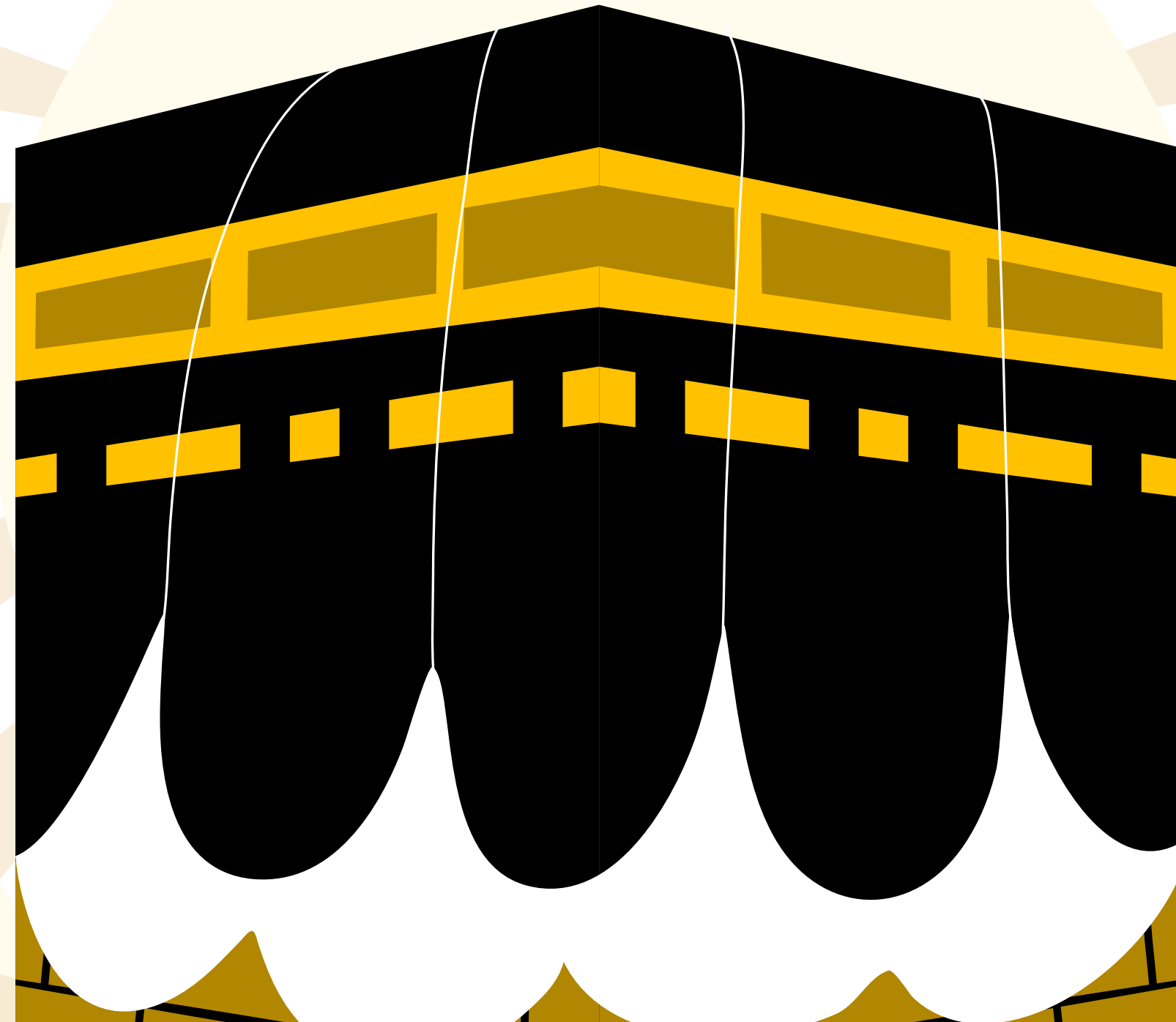
THE STORY OF PROPHET NUH AS  
(NOAH)

- *Prophet Nuh AS (Noah) was a wise and kind man, a Prophet of Allah SWT who lived for over 1,100 years.*

# LESSON 3 / 4

- Ibrahim AS was one of the greatest Prophets, known for his strong faith in Allah SWT from a young age.

- The story teaches us to always listen to Allah SWT and trust in His rewards, even through tough tests.



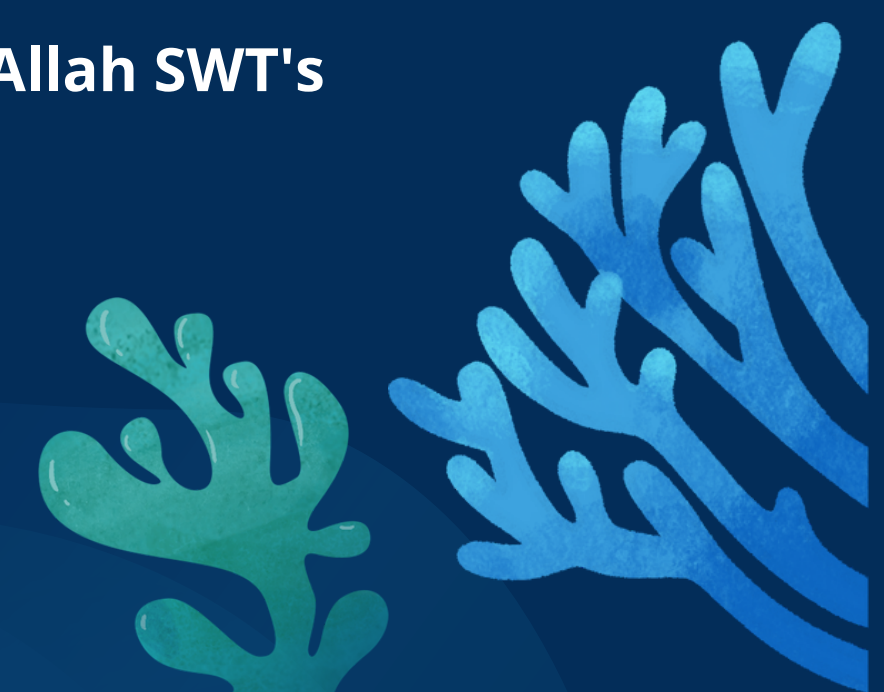

# LESSON 5

The Story of Prophet  
Yunus AS (Jonah)



- In Nineveh, people forgot about Allah SWT, so He sent Prophet Yunus AS.

# Lesson 8/9

THE STORY OF  
MUHAMMAD SAW





## PART ONE

- **Prophet Muhammad SAW is the final messenger, saved for last by Allah SWT.**
- **Muhammad SAW was born in Makkah; his father Abdullah died before he was born, making him an orphan.**
- **He was raised by his foster mother, Halimah, who noticed blessings when he stayed with her.**
- **His mother, Aminah, died when he was 6 years old, and then he lived with his grandfather and later his uncle, both of whom loved and protected him.**
- **In Makkah, most people worshipped idols and behaved cruelly, treating the poor, women, slaves, and animals unfairly.**
- **Muhammad SAW was different; he was kind, caring, patient, trustworthy, and honest.**
- **He was called Al-Ameen (the trustworthy) and Al-Saddiq (the truthful) because everyone trusted him with their valuables.**
- **The story teaches that Prophets are honest, trustworthy, and reliable, and we should strive to be the same.**





## PART TWO

- **Muhammad SAW** grew up into a handsome young man and worked for a woman named **Khadijah RA**.
- **Khadijah RA** was impressed by his manners, hard work, and honesty. They married and had 4 daughters and 2 sons.
- At 40 years old, **Allah SWT** sent **Angel Jibril AS** to tell **Muhammad SAW** he was chosen to be a Prophet.
- **Muhammad SAW** was frightened when he first saw **Jibril AS** and ran to **Khadijah RA** for comfort.
- **Khadijah RA** reassured him, highlighting his good qualities: helping the weak, poor, and needy, being kind and generous, and being truthful.
- **Khadijah RA's** wise cousin confirmed that **Jibril AS** was the same angel sent to **Musa** and that **Muhammad SAW** was destined for great things.
- **Angel Jibril AS** brought the words of the **Qur'an** to **Muhammad SAW** for 23 years.
- Despite challenges, **Muhammad SAW** delivered **Allah SWT's** message with the best of manners.
- **Allah SWT** says in the **Qur'an**: "Indeed you (O **Muhammad SAW**) are of outstanding character" (68:4).
- The story teaches us that **Muhammad SAW** is the best example to follow, and by copying his actions, **Allah SWT** will love us too.
